## 124. Chair's welcome

The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting and explained the meeting protocol.

## 125. Apologies for absence

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr Saunders. Cllr Dunne proposed acceptance of the apologies. This was seconded by Cllr Green with all in favour.

# 126. Declarations of Interest

Cllr Greene declared a non-pecuniary interest in item 131.1 on the agenda as he is a district councillor.

### 127. Minutes of the previous meeting

Cllr Graham proposed that the minutes of Planning and Highways Committee meetings held on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2023 be adopted as an accurate record of the meeting. This was seconded by Cllr Dunne with all in favour.

128. Public participation on Planning Applications. There were no members of the public present.

# 129. Planning Applications to be considered

129.1 DC/23/4139/FUL | Retrospective Application - Enclosing existing pagoda | 74 Heritage Green Kessingland Lowestoft Suffolk NR33 7UP

Councillors discussed this application and noted the concerns that had been raised by a resident at a neighbouring property. As noted in the neighbours response, the garden structure, under permitted development rules, exceeds the maximum height that a building enclosure or container can be. The rules state that the maximum height is 2.5 metres, but this enclosure surpasses that as it is 2.6 metres in height, and is within 2 metres curtilage of the dwelling. The parish council is also concerned that retrospective approval undermines the planning system unless there are mitigating circumstances. Therefore, Cllr Truman recommends refusal of this application. This was seconded by Cllr Glendinning with all in favour.

129.2 DC/23/4015/DRC | Discharge of Condition 9 of DC/22/2285/FUL - (Construction of a house, parking and amenity space) - Plan submitted to show

the means to discharge surface water away from highway | Roosevelt Green Lane Kessingland Lowestoft Suffolk NR33 7RP

Councillors discussed this application and Cllr Graham proposed that the committee recommend approval of this application as long as the application adheres to recommendations made by the Highways Authority. This was seconded by Cllr Green with all in favour.

130. To receive East Suffolk Council (ESC) responses to Planning Applications. 130.1 None
