105. Welcome

The Chair welcomed the committee and explained the meeting protocol.

106. Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr Saunders with the acceptance of apologies for absence proposed by Cllr Cook and seconded by Cllr Glendinning with all in favour.

107. Declarations of Interest

There were no Declarations of Disclosable Pecuniary, Other Registerable and Non-Registerable Interests from councillors on items on the Agenda and there are no written requests for dispensations for Disclosable Pecuniary Interests. A dispensation has been granted to:

Cllr Green in respect of his role as district councillor.

Cllr McLean in respect of Kessingland Sports & Social Centre & Kessingland CofE Primary Academy.

108. Minutes of the previous meeting

The minutes of the Finance & Governance Committee meeting held on 4th December 2024 had been circulated. Cllr Glendinning proposed adoption as a true and accurate record. This was seconded by Cllr McLean with all in favour.

109. Banking

- 109.1 Cllrs received the RFO monthly report.
- 109.2 Cllrs noted the current balances from the report. Cllr Green proposed that £40,000 be transferred from the Unity deposit account to the Unity current account. This was seconded by Cllr Graham with all in favour.

- 109.3 Cllrs noted the payments made via direct debit and standing orders from the report.
- 109.4 Cllrs noted the payments made under delegated responsibility from the report.
- 109.5 Cllrs noted the payments made via council business cards from the report.
- 109.6 Cllrs noted the payments made via petty cash from the report.

110. Payments

110.1 Cllr Glendinning proposed that all payment detailed on the RFO's monthly report are authorised. This was seconded by Cllr McLean with all in favour.

111. Accounts and Audit

- 111.1 Cllrs noted the £50,000 transfer from the Nationwide account to CCLA has not yet been actioned as a form is required to be completed by the four signatories to the account. Nationwide require a nominated account to release funds to and after discussion the committee decided to use the Unity current account as it would be easier to transfer funds from here.
- 111.2 There was no update regarding the Compass Suite bank account to receive.

112. Other financial matters

- An update from the Budget Working Group who held their meeting on 18th December 2024 was received. The decision was proposed by Cllr Green to set the Precept 2025/26 at £184,217.24. This was seconded by Cllr Cook with one abstention and five in favour of.
- 112.2 It was noted that a phone contract with Vodafone for the office phone and broadband will soon be in place.
- 112.3 Cllrs considered a funding request from Kessingland Bowls Club. Cllr Cook proposed funding of £1,000 to be given. This was seconded by Cllr Glendinning with all in favour.

113. Governance

113.1 Councillors reviewed the Data Protection Policy and it was agreed that an amendment was required to include a clause that states that all council business should be dealt with via councillor email addresses and not personal ones. The amendment will be made and brought before full council for adoption.
